AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIPS

(professional musicians/studio music teachers will adjudicate)

Young Artists Scholarships

\$2,000 in total scholarships
(2-4 scholarships are awarded at the judges' discretion, but the full \$2,000 is awarded.)

High School Showcase Recital Awards

\$250 award
(6-8 awards are typically granted. Winners must perform in the recital to receive the award.)

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

- Eligibility:** Open to high school vocal and instrumental students in grades 10-12 who reside in Milwaukee, Racine, Waukesha, Washington or Ozaukee County
- Minimum Level:** Class A – WSMA *(While the piece must be at this level, it need not be on the actual list.)*
- Live Audition:** Four to six minutes of performance time is required. Any six minute portion of longer pieces may be chosen by cutting long introductions or accompaniment interludes. The timer will stop the performer at six minutes without penalty. Memorization is optional.
- Repertoire:** Instrumentalists: one piece or one movement of a multi-movement piece
Vocalists: one or more songs to fulfill the time requirement
- Accompanists:** Auditionees are expected to perform with an accompanist and must provide their own (unless the piece is meant to be unaccompanied).
- Attire:** Performance attire
